Regular access to the de-sense programme has had limited success and no measurable increased tolerance at this stage.

Tolerated adult involvement in parallel play alongside pupil. • Gave pupil an experience of a new community setting (without public present) and demonstrated to him a positive activity following a short journey in a vehicle. • Promoted positive engagement within music therapy sessions, creating a greater understanding of cause and effect, building tolerance for interaction with different sounds and sensations. • Non-flip TEACCH independent work-station and specialist seating to support seated movement has had some initial impact however presentation of alternative behaviours e.g. climbing on the desk as more difficult to move and turn over. • Pupil now has access to a sensory regulation bag that can be taken with him wherever he goes and used as preventative strategy to avoid escalation of behaviours.
