



## **The Shires at Stretton School 2020-21 Academic Performance Statement**

### **Pupil performance in relation to EHCP outcomes (all pupils including new starters)**

- **58.8%** of the total cohort are **secure in at least 75%** of their expected progress outcomes.
- **29.5%** of the total cohort are **secure in 100%** of their expected progress outcomes.

### **EHCP – Four areas of SEND, linked to PfA outcomes (all pupils including new starters)**

- **Cognition and Learning (PfA – Employment) a total of 58.8%** of expected progress outcomes across the school cohort **were secure**.
- **Communication and Interaction (PfA – Community Inclusion) a total of 58.8%** of expected progress outcomes across the school cohort **were secure**.
- **Sensory & Physical (PfA – Independent Living) a total of 52.9%** of expected progress outcomes across the school cohort **were secure**.
- **Social, Emotional and Mental Health (PfA – Health) a total of 64.7%** of expected progress outcomes across the school cohort **were secure**.
